1. Review

- a. The church is being persecuted by Saul of Tarsus.
- b. Philip preaches in Samaria with terrific results
- c. Peter and John pray people through to the Holy Ghost.
- d. Simon tries to purchase this power and is rebuked
- e. Phillip is led away from the Revival by the spirit of God.

2. Be Open and Available - Acts 8:5-6

- a. Philip wasn't praying to be miraculously transported
- b. He just wanted to be used of God

3. Don't get Stuck

- a. Philip began his ministry in Samaria because of the threat of Saul (Acts 8:4-5).
- b. Let go of your plans and adjust to do the will of God.

4. Avoid Discrimination

- a. Jews and Samaritans were mortal enemies and would generally have nothing to do with each other.
- b. Don't pick and choose who you reach out to.

5. **Ministry is about Working Together -** Acts 8:14-15

- a. It's not about one person's ministry
- b. Peter and John came to help with the Revival and pray people through to the Holy Ghost.

6. Obey the leading of God's spirit - Acts 8:26-27

- a. The Angel of the Lord told him to leave
- b. no details, no plan, just walk
- c. What matters is following after God and being willing to do whatever He asks.
