1. The Church Began in Prayer – Acts 1:4-5
 - a. 500 Started – 120 Stayed with it
 - i. 1 Corinthians 15:4-6
 - ii. Pentecost is 50 Days from the first day after the Sabbath following the Passover.
 1. Saturday March 27, 2021 – Passover (also the Sabbath)
 2. Sunday, March 28, 2021 – Day 1 of 50
 3. Sunday, May 16, 2021 – Pentecost
 - iii. Jesus met with His disciples for 40 days leading up to Pentecost. He ascended on day 40 – Acts 1:3
 - iv. They prayed in the upper room for 10 days
 - b. When you don't know what to do...pray – Acts 1:13-14
2. New Leaders through Prayer
 - a. Peter was led to replace Judas – Acts 1:16, 20-23
 - i. Nominated qualified people
 - ii. Prayed
 - iii. Cast lots
3. Day of Pentecost
 - a. Jewish Festival celebrating the harvest
 - b. 1 of 3 festivals where Men were required to present themselves at the Temple
 - c. Day 1 – Present a wave offering to the Lord
 - d. Day 50 – 2 Loaves of yeasted and salted bread + animal sacrifices.
 - e. Joyful celebration
 - f. Traditions associated with Pentecost
 - i. King David's Birth and Death
 - ii. Ruth becomes a Jew on Pentecost
 - iii. Law of Moses given at Sinai

4. Outpouring of God's Spirit – Acts 2:2-12

a. Wind

- i. God breathes the 'breath/wind' of life into Adam
- ii. Ezekiel prophesies to the wind and the breathes life into dead bones – Ezekiel 37:9-10
- iii. Jesus said the New Birth is like the blowing of the wind – John 3:8

b. Tongues of Fire

- i. Tabernacle of Moses – Exodus 40:34-38
- ii. Pillar of Fire – Exodus 13:16-17
- iii. Fire engulfed Mt. Sinai – Exodus 24:17
- iv. Fire on Mt. Carmel – 1 Kings 18:37-38
- v. Sacrifice of David – 1 Chronicles 21:26
- vi. Solomon's temple – 2 Chronicles 7:1

c. Speak with Tongues – Acts 2:2-12

- i. Tower of Babel

5. This is That – Acts 2:13-18

- a. Not everyone will embrace the message right away
- b. The reach of the church is global
- c. Every age-group will be involved
- d. It's not for a select few
