1. Salvation Message – Acts 2:37-39
 - a. “When they heard this...”
 - b. Everyone is in the same boat – Colossians 2:14
 - c. Peter told them to
 - i. Repent
 - ii. Be baptized in Jesus’ Name
 - iii. Receive the Holy Ghost
 - d. Repentance is Essential
 - i. God resists the proud – gives grace to the humble – James 4:6
 - ii. Repentance is a confession of faith, and an act of seeking God – Hebrews 11:6
 - iii. It’s an initial response to the Kingdom of God – Matthew 3:2
 - iv. Repentance brings me into God’s presence and invites His Holy Spirit to overshadow me – Psalms 51:11
 - v. It is the call of Jesus on every man – Luke 5:32
 - vi. Confess your sin – Proverbs 28:13
 - e. Baptism is essential
 - i. Part of the new birth – John 3:5
 - ii. Jesus emphasized and commanded it – Matthew 28:19, Mark 16:16
 - iii. For the remission of sins – Acts 2:38
 - iv. Puts me into the body of Christ – Galatians 3:27
 - v. It saves us like the ark saved Noah and his family – 1 Peter 3:21
 - vi. It’s a burial – Colossians 2:12
 - vii. We take on the name, character, and authority of Jesus
 - f. Baptism is done only in the name of Jesus
 - i. Peter declared it on the birth of the church – Acts 2:38
 - ii. The Samaritans– Acts 8:12

- iv. John's disciples were re-baptized – Acts 19:5
- v. The only mention of titles was in Matthew 28:19

2. Fellowship of the Church – Acts 2:42-47

- a. Early Church Priorities
 - i. Teaching doctrine
 - ii. Fellowship and Breaking Bread
 - iii. Prayer
 - iv. Caring for one another - Generosity
 - v. Worship
 - vi. Reaching the lost
- b. They were not a “once a week” Christian
 - i. They met daily (Acts 2:46)
 - ii. cared daily (Acts 6:1)
 - iii. won souls daily (Acts 2:47)
 - iv. searched the Scriptures daily (Acts 17:11)
 - v. and increased in number daily (Acts 16:5).
- c. Are we given to prayer?
 - i. “how big is my memorial of prayer?”
 - ii. Is it affecting Kings and nations or just built to meet the needs of my life?
- d. Are we a community of disciples?
 - i. “provoke unto love and good works” (Hebrews 10:24)
 - ii. “encourage & urge one another daily” (Hebrews 3:13)
 - iii. “build up one another” (1 Thessalonians 5:11)
 - iv. “confess your faults one to another” (James 5:16)
 - v. “bear ye one another's burdens” (Galatians 6:2)
- e. Do we give like the early church?
 - i. And all who believed...were selling their possessions...and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need.” (Acts 2:44-45)
- f. When we do what we’re supposed to do EVERYDAY, then God does what only He can do EVERYDAY!
