1. Armageddon and the Second Coming
  - a. 10 kings follow the Antichrist and give Him their full allegiance - Revelation 17:16-17
  - b. Jesus returns and the Antichrist assembles the world to fight Him. Jude 1:14-15, 1 Thessalonians 3:13
  - c. Description of Jesus Revelation 19:11-18
    - i. Eyes were like flames of fire
    - ii. Many Crowns
    - iii. New Name
    - iv. Robe dipped in Blood
    - v. Armies of Heaven dressed in white
    - vi. Sharp sword from his Mouth (words)
    - vii. Rule with a rod of Iron
    - viii. King of Kings

#### **"The First and Second Comings of Jesus Christ"**

<b>His First Coming</b>	<b>His Second Coming</b>
He rode a donkey.	He will ride a white horse.
He came as the Suffering Servant.	He will come as King and Lord.
He came in humility and meekness.	He will come in majesty and power.
He came to suffer the wrath of God for sinners.	He will come to establish the kingdom of God for His saints.
He was rejected by many as the Messiah.	He will be recognized by all as Lord.
He came to seek and save the lost.	He will come to judge and rule as King.
He came as God incognito.	He will come as God in all His splendor.

2. The Millennium
  - a. Conditions of the Millennium
    - i. 1000 Years

- ii. Jesus will be King and will judge righteously
- iii. The church will reign as kings and priests (Revelation 5:10)
- iv. All of creation will be under man's dominion again (Zechariah 14:4-5)
- v. Israel will accept Jesus as Messiah
- vi. No more war (Isaiah 2:4, Hosea 2:18)
- vii. Knowledge of the Lord will abound
- viii. Sickness will be removed
- ix. Economic prosperity

b. First Resurrection

- i. Revelation 20:3-6
- ii. Jesus is the first fruits of the Resurrection
- iii. The Church was resurrected at the rapture
- iv. Tribulation saints who remain committed to Christ to the very end.
- v. The Second death has no power over them

c. Rod of Iron

- i. Jesus' government will not be wishy washy or corrupted.
- ii. Judgment will always be fair and righteous

d. Satan will be loosed

- i. Even after 1000 years with a perfect leader – mankind will be swayed.
- ii. This demonstrates that the problems of the world are not solved with the perfect leader or perfect peace. The issue is the heart of Man.

3. Second Resurrection

- a. The rest of humanity is brought back to life to stand before the White Throne Judgment. Revelation 20:11-13
- b. Seven Judgments
  - i. Judgment of sin at the Cross, Hebrews 9:26-28
  - ii. Judgment of ourselves, I Corinthians 11:31
  - iii. Judgment of Correction, Hebrews 12:5-6.
  - iv. Judgment of saints' works, I Corinthians 3:11-15.

- vi. Judgment of nations after the Tribulation, Matthew 25:31-46.
- vii. Great White Throne judgment (the wicked), Revelation 20:11-14.

4. New Heaven and New Earth – Revelation 21:1-8

- a. New Jerusalem – Capital of the New World (Revelation 22:1-7)
  - i. It was bright and shining
  - ii. 12 gates (made with a single pearl) guarded by angels
  - iii. 12 foundations – each of a different gem
  - iv. 1400 Miles square – almost covering the USA
  - v. City is made of Jasper and Pure Gold
  - vi. Jesus is the light of the city
  - vii. Nothing evil will ever enter the city
