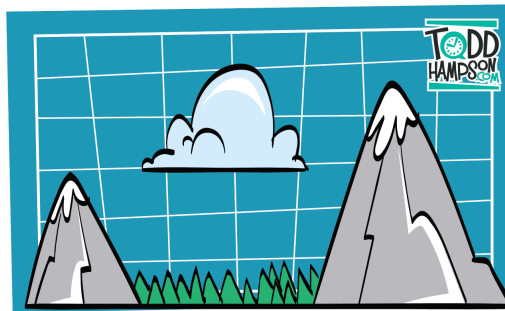

2. Old Testament Timeline

- a. Creation & Adam's Fall into Sin
- b. The Flood
- c. God makes a covenant with Abraham (Genesis 12:2-3; 3:8: 3:14)
- d. God makes a Covenant with the Nation Israel
- e. Prophetic Promises throughout the OT
 - i. Daniel; 7, 9 & 12
 - ii. Joel 2 & 3
 - iii. Ezekiel 37, 38
 - iv. Zechariah 12-14

3. New Testament Timeline

- a. Jesus is Born
- b. Jesus is Crucified and Resurrected
 - i. This is the beginning of the fulfillment of the "end-times"
- c. Holy Ghost Poured Out
- d. Church Age (Matthew 24:9-14)
- e. Rapture of the Church
- f. Judgment seat of Christ/Marriage Supper
- g. Tribulation
- h. Second Coming of Jesus

- i. The antichrist will lose and Jesus will reign over the world for 1000 years.
 - ii. The Church will return to rule the world under the Kingdom of Jesus Christ.
- i. Judgment Day
- j. Eternity begins

- 4. The Second Coming vs. the Rapture
 - a. the Rapture and the Second coming of Jesus Christ are NOT the same thing. (Jude 1:14-15)
 - b. The church is COMING BACK with Jesus (Revelation 19:11-15)

- 5. The Rapture: Catching away of the Saints (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18)
 - a. We need to be ready
 - b. Romans 13:11-14, Ephesians 5:14-20
